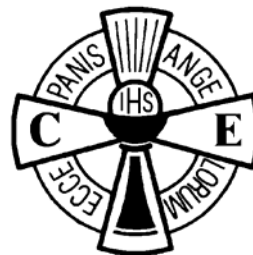

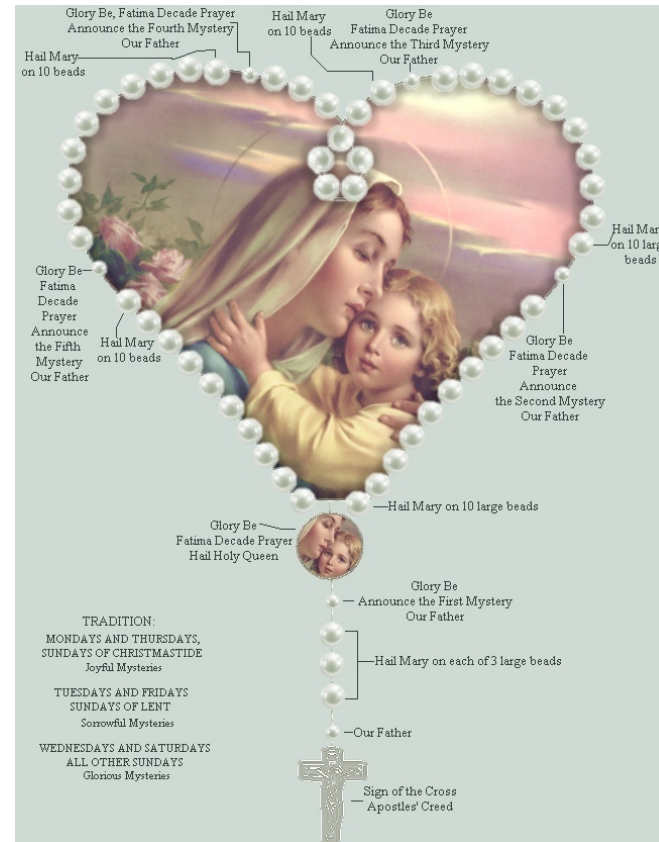
The Power of the Rosary

Blessed Thomas of St. John was well known for his sermons on the Rosary. Many people loved his sermons because he explained so well the beautiful mysteries of the Rosary. He explained that the Joyful Mysteries were about the Holy Family and the Child Jesus when He was young.
